The three committees working at the hospital on a regular basis include:

1. Book Cart: Work two afternoons a month (for about an hour) and fill a book cart committee spot. The Committee has openings and subs are always needed.
2. East Lobby Greeter's Desk: Work one morning or one afternoon a week answering the phone, directing traffic, helping with office work, and serving as the first point of contact for most people with PMHC. There are openings on Thursdays for this desk.
3. Surgery Waiting Area, West Lobby: Help family members understand the time frame of the patient's surgery, work with surgery crew, doctors and family members. The schedules change often and substitutes are always needed. Some office work is available if interested.
