What are epidural steroid injections?

An intervention involving the injection of antiinflammatory medication to help relieve pain and numbness of the back and legs.

How long will the procedure take?

The procedure itself will take about 10 minutes, with 30 minutes following the procedure for monitoring. You should plan to spend 1 1/2 hours for your initial visit to allow time for discussion & questions. Subsequent visits & procedures will only take 30-45 minutes.
