Please arrive at the hospital 15 minutes prior to your appointment to check in.

What is MRI?

Magnetic Resonance Imaging is a simple procedure that uses a magnet & special computer to produce pictures of the body.

How is the procedure performed?

You will lie within a magnetic field. There is no radiation used. You must lie very still, on your back, for about 30 minutes. Some exams require the injection of a MRI contrast agent. Following the exam patients can resume all of their normal activities.

Preparation

Abdomen exams - Do not eat or drink for 6 hours before the exam.

All other MRI exams - No preparation.

Please wear comfortable clothing without metal. Hospital gowns are available.

Safety Screening

The MRI technologist will ask you questions regarding your past medical history and previous surgeries.

How will I get the results?

A radiologist will evaluate the test and prepare a report to be sent to your doctor. It may take several days to receive this report from your doctor.
